### First Day Treat Bag Topper

All you need for a fun first day of school prize is snack size Ziploc bags, Cookie Crisp cereal or small chocolate chip cookies, & the tag from the next page.

Children will color & cut out each cookie and fold in half. They will then place yarn or ribbon inside the fold and glue the cookie shut against the ribbon like a sandwich.



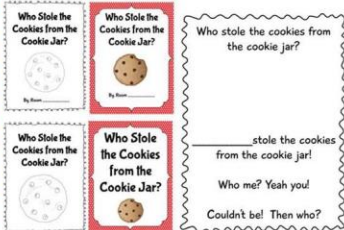
### Be a Chocolate Chip Friend Writing & Craft

Share the friendship quote with your class & have a discussion about ways to be a good friend. You students can use the cookies with friendly ideas already printed or they can write their own ideas on the blank cookies. There is also a handwriting page and two versions of cookie stationary pages for your students to write more about friendship.



### Class Book

After each class member has had a turn to be the cookie thief, have each child complete the class book page using his or her own name. Class books using names are always popular items in my class library, especially during the first weeks of school. I have included 4 different versions of the cover page for you to choose from.



### Grab a Cookie, Share an Answer

Print out the question cookies in color or black & white. It's fun to put these into a real cookie jar or you can use a manila envelope with the "Getting to Know Some Smart Cookies" picture on the front. Either way have children take turns to pull a cookie from the jar. The child then answers the question.



### Class Compliment Cookie Jar

Display the Compliment Cookie Jar on your white board or another prominent spot in your classroom. Your class will be excited to add cookies as they receive compliments for excellent behavior around school. Offering a special experience or reward when the class fills the cookie jar will help your class stay motivated!

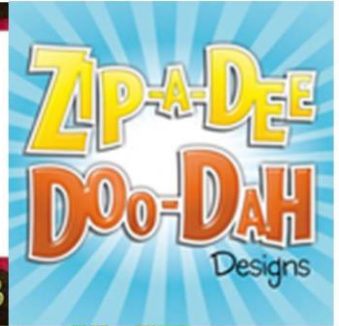
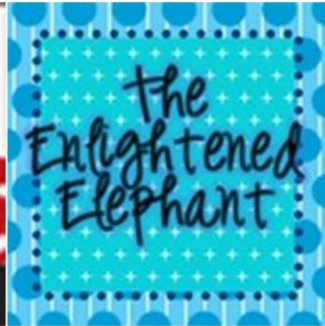
